

**Assistant Professor in Quantitative Research Methods** in Human Development and Family Science (HDFS), Oklahoma State University, Stillwater, OK. Nine-month tenure-track appointment, starting August 2023.

**REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Earned doctorate in human development & family science (or a related field) or a quantitative/statistics field with experience working in the field of social sciences from an accredited university.
- Expertise in advanced multivariate and multilevel statistics and methods including an ability to run power analyses for advanced statistical approaches.
- Research productivity in an area relevant to HDFS, evidenced by peer-reviewed publications.
- Ability to teach advanced statistics at the graduate level.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate and interact effectively with collaborators on research projects.
- Engage in responsibilities consistent with a comprehensive land-grant University.
- Fulfill other duties as assigned.
- Successful candidate must provide evidence of employment eligibility as required.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Advanced knowledge of data management strategies and on-line systems (e.g., Qualtrics or REDCap).
- Experience conducting program evaluations in community settings.
- Experience contributing to and/or leading research grant proposals.
- Experience working with diverse populations.
- Experience in biostatistics and dyadic data analysis.
